The following types of cookies are installed by this Website:

 - Vimeo (3rd Party) last for 1 year: Remember users player mode.
 This is remembered by the website for us to allow it to play where it plays in the header
 - Google Recaptcha (3rd Party) last for 6 months: stopping spam
 - Vimeo (3rd Party) last for 30 minutes Antispam from Vimeo
- Functional cookies: They allow the user to use the website with some preferences. These are:
 - Vimeo (3rd Party) 1 year: Something vimeo use to track the video playing on individual websites.
- Analytical cookies: They allow us to quantify the number of users and thus to carry out the measurement and statistical analysis of the use made by users of the service offered.
 These are:
 - Analytics (1st Party) last for 1 year: Used by google analytics to track usage of the site
 - Analytics (1st Party last for 1 year: Again, used by analytics but to distinguish between new and returning visitors

How do we collect your data?

When you visit our website there is certain information that we will automatically collect, whether or not you decide to use our services namely your IP address, the date and the times and frequency with which you access the website, the way you browse its content and other technical information. We will also collect data from you when you contact us via the website, for example by using a contact us form.
